

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS**  
pursuant to art. 22 paragraph 4 letter a) of Italian Law no. 240/2010 of 30/12/2010 and the Research  
Fellowships Regulation issued by Rector's Decree no. 416 of 19/04/2011

**Protocol num. 961 of 25.05.2021**

**Art. 1 — Purpose**

A public competition, based on qualifications and an interview, is hereby initiated at the **Department of Political and Social Science**, Alma Mater Studiorum-University of Bologna, Strada Maggiore 45, Bologna, in order to award 4 A-type research fellowships, following the provisions of art. 2, paragraph 1, letter a) of the Research Fellowships Regulation issued by Rector's Decree no.416 of 19/04/2011. One fellowship is awarded in each of the following **scientific fields**:

- 1. Comparative Politics (area 14/A2)**
- 2. Cultural and Communication Sociology (area 14/C2);**
- 3. Political History and Theory (areas 11/A3, 13/C1, 14/A1, 14/B1);**
- 4. Law (areas 12/E1, 12/E4).**

Within the above scientific areas, research projects focusing on the following research topics, currently under investigation by the Department's members, will be taken into consideration.

**Comparative politics**

Political processes in a comparative perspective (area 14/A2): political science in its subfields concerning comparative politics, political parties and interest groups, democratic institutions, non-democratic regimes and democratic transitions, the Italian political system, the political system of the European Union, political language and political communication, parties' competition and electoral competition, legislative behaviour, regionalism and autonomy, political cultures, theoretical approaches to domestic politics (rational choice, neo-institutionalism and others), comparative political economy.

**Cultural and communication sociology**

Sociology of cultural and communication processes (area 14/C2): cultural, axiological, communication and media processes; the social impact of mass media, digital media, social media and artificial intelligence; socialization and training processes; sociology of family and social policies targeted at families; sociology of religion; sociology of education; gender-media relationships.

**Political history and theory**

Contemporary history, economic history, political philosophy, history of political doctrines and institutions (areas 11/A3, 13/C1, 14/A1, 14/B1): analysis of authors, doctrines, theories, concepts, and political, social, economic and cultural phenomena which have characterized the modern and contemporary age from a philosophical-political, historical-conceptual, and political history perspective; history and theories of constitutional structures, main state-level and international-level institutions.

**Law**

International law and European Union law (areas 12/E1, 12/E4): research related to the relationships between states, with specific regards to structural features of international law; its articulations in

different domains, its adaptation to national law, international organisations, including European cooperation legal status, human rights protection law, researches related to legal aspects of the European integration process, with regards to the legislative, administrative and jurisdictional competences of European Union bodies, their relations with Member States and their legal systems; analysis of fundamental freedoms' legal framework within the European community, European Union policies and regulatory instruments affecting national legislation.

The research fellowships are issued pursuant to the University Regulation issued by Rector's Decree no. 416 of April 19, 2011, financed by the Department's integrated research budget funds (BIR) 2021, resolved by the Departmental Board in its March 25, 2021 session.

Candidates meeting the admission requirements listed in art. 2 below shall submit an original research project in relation to one of the above-specified fields of investigation together with their completed application form, including a list of qualifications and publications.

The activities will be performed under the supervision of a tutor identified by the Department Board among the research and teaching staff affiliated with the Department. The tutor will supervise the activities of the research fellow, which will be performed in a non-subordinate relationship with no fixed working hours.

### ***Art. 2 — Candidacy requirements***

The selection procedure is open to any candidate, without age or nationality limitations, possessing a Ph.D. or any similar qualification, i.e. recognized as equivalent for the current selection procedure.

Candidates must possess the admission requirements before the deadline for submission of applications laid down in this call.

The selection is not open to:

- any person related, by blood or by marriage up to the fourth degree, to a professor working in the Department for which the call is issued, or to the Rector, Director General or a member of the Board of Governors of the University;
- permanent staff of Italian Universities and research centres pursuant to Law no. 240/2010, article 22 sub-paragraph 1;
- anyone who has held research fellowship contracts with any institution, pursuant to Italian Law no. 240/2010, for a period which, added to the foreseen duration of this contract, exceeds a total of 6 years, excluding any period in which the contract coincided with a Ph.D. without scholarship, for the maximum limit of the legal duration of the Ph.D. programme;
- anyone who has had research fellowship or fixed-term researcher contracts at the University of Bologna or any other state-funded, privately-funded or distance-learning Italian university pursuant to articles 22 and 24 of Italian Law no. 240/2010, or with any other body listed in paragraph 1 of Art. 22 of Italian Law no. 240/2010 for a period which, added to the foreseen duration of this contract, exceeds a total of 12 (even non-consecutive) years. For the purposes of the duration of the above-described periods, in compliance with the laws in force, any periods of maternity or sick leave shall not be calculated.

### ***Art. 3 — Application***

Applications may only be submitted online by accessing the website: <https://concorsi.unibo.it>, after completing the registration process according to the web procedure instructions.

**Applications must be submitted by 05 July 2021.** Applications submitted after this deadline will not be considered.

The date shown on the acknowledgement of receipt sent electronically to the candidate is deemed to be the date of the application submission.

The Department is in no way responsible for applications submitted after the above-mentioned deadline or not submitted at all.

All notices will be published on the Department of Political and Social Sciences website: <http://www.dsps.unibo.it/it>, "Calls" section and on the University web page "Calls, tenders and competitions": <https://bandi.unibo.it/ricerca/assegni-ricerca> (specific link related to this selection procedure). These communications are equal to notifications to applicants.

In the online application, candidates must follow the web procedure instructions and specify, under their own responsibility:

- surname and name;
- date and place of birth;
- nationality;
- residence and chosen address for correspondence for the purposes of this selection;
- that they have no criminal record nor are involved in any current criminal proceedings (or state any exceptions to this condition);
- that they have the qualification of ..... awarded by..... date.....  
(specify the qualifications required by art. 2 of the call for applications, including the university and year of award);  
*or*
- that they possess an academic qualification earned abroad acknowledged as equivalent.

Candidates with a qualification earned abroad must include in their applications a translation into Italian or English of their foreign qualification, accompanied by a sworn statement that it is a accurate translation of the original certificate. The foreign qualification may be declared admissible by the evaluation board solely for the purposes of participation in the selection procedure.

In case they are awarded the research fellowship, candidates with a qualification earned in a country outside of the European Union must provide the Department, in the same manner as laid down for the presentation of applications, an official translation with a declaration of value of the foreign qualification issued by the competent diplomatic representation or Italian consulate in their home country, in accordance with the applicable laws, within 30 days from the notification of official approval of the selection procedure reports. If the documents are not received by the Department within the stated deadline, the candidate will not be awarded the contract.

Candidates' applications must include an original research project which has not been developed in collaboration with others or the original drafting of which cannot be claimed by others. The project — written in English and no more than 3000 words long (excluding bibliographic references and tables/figures) — needs to be directly connected to one of the four scientific areas listed in article 1 of this call for applications and must clearly specify the relevant scientific area.

In the framework of this call for application candidates might formulate only one research project. Failure to respect this provision entails exclusion from the selection procedure.

The project shall indicate the specific purpose and outcomes of the research and the project development timetable.

It is also recommended to include a section related to the theoretical reference framework and the scientific relevance of the proposed research, a section presenting the main research questions and hypotheses, a methodological section illustrating the possible analytical perspectives, the tools, the techniques to be used in the research and any further element facilitating evaluation of its practical and scientific feasibility.

Candidates must also enclose to their applications the following documents in .pdf format (failure to do so entails exclusion from the selection procedure):

- a copy of a valid identity document;
- a scientific and professional curriculum vitae highlighting the candidate's educational path, his/her post-doc research activity, his/her participation to conferences, national and international research projects and a list of any scientific publications.

At any time, even after participation in any stage of the selection procedure, the Department may, with justification, exclude a candidate from the selection procedure. The concerned candidate will be notified of such exclusion through an e-mail sent to the e-mail address which has been indicated in the application.

Applicants requiring special arrangements (hereinafter Adaptations) to participate to the examination, should submit specific documents as detailed below:

- diagnosis of Specific Learning Disorders, according to the Italian Law 170/2010, issued by the National Health Service (Servizio Sanitario Nazionale) or by a private affiliated body or private professional including a document of conformity issued by the National Health Service itself. These documents must have a date of issue that does not exceed three years from the date of the application, or must have been issued after reaching the age of eighteen (*Due to Covid-19 emergency, which have provoked a reduction of National Health Services' clinics activity, documents older than three years proving a diagnosis of Specific Learning Disorders, according to the Italian Law 170/2010, will be considered valid, upon the condition to request integrations of documents provided, once National Health Services' clinics normal activity will be restored.*)

- handicap certificate according to the Italian Law 104/92;

- disability certificate;

- documentation proving a disorder that may determine a physical/mental inability, even temporary, (i.e. health conditions which may lead to certain specific needs during the examination);

(Please note: If an applicant owns both certifications according to the Italian Law 104/92 and some other medical documentation, it is strongly recommended to submit all of them.)

Applicants with disabilities or with Specific Learning Disorders, residing in foreign Countries who need to ask for adaptations, must submit an official document certifying such a disability or learning disorder issued in the Country of residence together with its official translation exclusively in Italian or English language.

Adaptations may consist in:

- extra time to take the examination (30% extra time for applicants submitting documents which certify Specific Learning Disorders, Special Educational Needs, pathologies; 50% extra time for applicants submitting documents which prove any disability and/or handicap as stated by the Italian Law 104/92)

- special aids available, such as reading aids, writing aids, non-scientific calculators, or other aids (the complete list of special aids can be found in the form).

In case of any organizational need and/or mandatory regulation that cannot ensure the required adaptations to applicants, an alternative but equivalent measure will be defined as well.

Candidates are admitted to the selection procedure with reserve.

#### ***Art. 4 — Comparative assessment of the candidates and evaluation board***

The candidates and their projects will be assessed comparatively by an evaluation board, formed by nine of the Department's professors and researchers.

The Department Board, after consulting the Department's delegate for research, appoints the evaluation board and its president.

The selection procedure will focus on the examination of:

- a) the submitted research project (maximum 35 points),
- b) the candidates' scientific-professional curriculum (maximum 15 points)
- c) the scientific capacity proved by last five years' publications listed in the CV (also in light of the time elapsed since the attainment of the PhD (maximum 15 points);
- d) an interview, aiming to verify each candidates' attitude and suitability for carrying out research (maximum 35 points)

In an initial phase, the evaluation board will assess the elements referred to in points a), b) and c). It will then admit to the oral interview (point d), in the light of those results, at least three candidates per each scientific area.

Candidates shall not take part in the evaluation of qualifications and research projects.

Notice of day, time, methods of conducting the public interview and list of admitted candidates will be published at least 7 days before the interview on the Department of Political and Social Science's website <http://www.dsps.unibo.it/it> , "Calls" section and on the University web page "Calls, tenders and competitions": <https://bandi.unibo.it/ricerca/assegni-ricerca> (specific link related to this selection procedure).

The communications on university web pages are equal to notifications to applicants, without obligation of any further communication. Candidates will be responsible for consulting the selection websites to find the necessary information.

#### ***Art. 5 — Procedure for conducting the interview***

Examinations will be public and will be held remotely through an audio/video teleconference system, i.e. the Microsoft Teams platform (the workstation chosen by the candidates for the interview must be equipped with a webcam - essential for the candidate's identification - a microphone, headphones and / or audio speakers), in compliance with the provisions of the recent Italian Prime Minister's Decrees, containing urgent measures regarding containment and management of the epidemiological emergency from COVID-19 and other regulatory provisions related the pandemic emergency.

Candidates admitted to the interview are invited to promptly communicate their email address to be used for interview via Microsoft Teams to the evaluation board at the following email address: [sps.direttore.mbx@unibo.it](mailto:sps.direttore.mbx@unibo.it).

At the beginning of the interview, candidates must show to the examination board the same identity document which was attached to their application.

The interview will take place in Italian and may take place in English upon request of the candidate. During the interview, the examination board will verify knowledge of English language on topics related to subjects referred to in the call for application.

At the end of the selection procedure, the examination Board will draw up a ranking list of candidates for each of the four areas listed in Art. 1.

The ranking list will be posted on the Department of Political and Social Science website <http://www.dsps.unibo.it/it>, "Calls" section and on the University web page "Calls, tenders and

competitions”: <https://bandi.unibo.it/ricerca/assegni-ricerca> (specific link related to this selection procedure).

The ranking list will remain valid for 5 months.

If two candidates receive the same score, preference will be given to the younger candidate.

The Head of Department shall confirm approval of the list drawn up by the examination Board through a decree.

The list of candidates may be used to award other research fellowships within the same scientific area, which may be of shorter duration than those indicated in the call for applications but in any case no shorter than one year.

#### ***Art. 6 — Duration and amount of the fellowship***

The research fellowships have a duration of 24 months.

The fellowships may be extended in the terms laid down in article 8 of the University Regulation concerning research fellowships, as issued by D.R. no. 416 of April 19, 2011.

The gross amount of the research fellowship contract is €19,367.00 per annum. The amount is exempt of withholding tax and includes all statutory social security charges to which research fellows are subject.

The amount will be paid in deferred monthly payments.

The research fellows are covered by accident insurance, against payment of the required contribution which will be withheld from the first monthly instalment.

#### ***Art. 7 — Contract signature***

Successful candidates will be invited to sign a contract for research activities with the Department no later than December 31, 2021.

Non-compliance within the deadline notified by the Department entails forfeiture of the right to sign the contract.

#### ***Art. 8 — Rights and duties***

For obligatory maternity leave, the contract is governed by the provisions of paragraph 6 art. 22 of Italian Law no. 240/2010.

Research activities are carried out under the supervision of the tutor, in a non-subordinate relationship with no fixed working hours. The research fellow shall personally carry out the required activities laid down in a work plan agreed with the tutor without any substitution. Except for authorized travel periods or explicit dispensation granted by the tutor, it is understood that research activities will be carried out at the Department of Political and Social Sciences. In the event of significant candidate's breaches with respect to the work plan, the tutor proposes to the Department Board the interruption of the contract and grant's disbursement.

At the end of the project activities, each research fellow shall present a detailed final report to the Quality into research Commission and the Department's Board, describing the activities carried out, the results achieved and the scientific production, accompanied by the tutor's written assessment.

The research fellow may spend a period of study abroad, according to a programme agreed with the Department of Political and Social Sciences and with expenses borne by the Department, without prejudice to the possibility to obtain specific funding.

### ***Art. 9 — Regulations concerning intellectual property***

Industrial property rights over the results achieved by the research fellow in the execution of research activities undertaken on behalf of the university, including but not limited to industrial inventions, models, drawings, plant varieties, as well as the intellectual and industrial property rights deriving from the production of software or databases ("Results"), belong exclusively to the university, which may freely use them also within agreements made by the departments with third parties, without prejudice to the moral rights of the research fellow who shall be acknowledged as the author or inventor.

The research fellow has the right to publish the results of his/her research activities, provided that the publication does not prejudice the rights of the university over the protection of the results.

If products elaborated during the fellowship are published, the research fellow must clearly acknowledge the affiliation to the Department. The research fellow therefore undertakes to promptly notify the achievement of the results to the tutor, who shall verify the existence of any such prejudice.

In any case the research fellow undertakes to sign a specific Undertaking of Confidentiality with the Department, which will be annexed to the contract.

### ***Art. 10 — Non-accumulation, incompatibility, leave***

The position of research fellow is incompatible with the following positions:

- a) fixed-term and full-time staff employed by the bodies listed in art. 22 par. 1 of Italian Law no. 240/2010;
- b) persons employed by any private bodies, on a fixed term, permanent or part-time basis;
- c) researcher with fixed-term research contracts with any university;
- d) adjunct professors with official teaching responsibilities in degree programmes or specialisation schools in any university;
- e) persons enrolled in any first-, second- or single-cycle degree programmes, Ph.D. programmes with scholarships or specialisation school. Self-funded research contracts are compatible with enrolments in non-medical specialisation schools, for which no study grant or contract is foreseen or master's degree, only where authorised in advance by the Department's Director, and having sought the opinion of the tutor.
- f) persons awarded research fellowships at any other body.

Employees of public administrations other than those listed in point a) with a fixed-term, permanent or part-time contract shall take unpaid leave of absence for the whole period of the research contract.

Freelance professional activities are compatible with the research fellowship contract if authorized in advance by the Department Council, gathering the tutor's motivated opinion on this and having verified that the activities in addition to the research fellowship do not prejudice the regular execution of the contract.

The accumulation of the research fellowship contract with study grants awarded for any purpose is not permitted, with the exception of those granted by national or foreign institutions for the purposes of integrating the research activities with study periods abroad.

The above requirements must be possessed from the moment of entry into force of the contract. Winning candidates shall sign a specific affidavit undertaking to notify the department any variations in the declared situations as soon as they occur.

### ***Art. 11 — Forfeiture***

Any candidate who does not sign the contract within the deadline notified by the Department, unless for promptly and duly demonstrated reasons of health or force majeure, shall forfeit the right to sign the contract.

In case of serious and significant breach to the provisions of Articles 1453 and subsequent articles of the Civil Code by the research fellow, the contract will be terminated. These occurrences must be reported and motivated by the tutor and notified to the Director of the Department, who can propose to the Department Board the interruption of the contract and grant disbursement.

### ***Art. 12 - Reference norms***

For any matters not laid down in this call for applications, please refer to the Regulation on Research Fellowships issued by the University of Bologna by Rectoral Decree no. 416 dated April 19, 2011 and other statutory regulations in force.

The submission of an application by a candidate in relation to the current selection procedure implies acceptance of the rules contained in this call for applications and the University Regulation on research fellowships.

In accordance with art. 13 of the EU Regulation 2016/679, the processing of the personal data provided by the applicants, participating to the selection procedure, or acquired for this purpose by the Department is solely aimed to carry out the activities related to selection procedure. Data will be managed by the people in charge of the selection procedure, including the Examination Board, in the manner and within the limits necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes, which may also be communicated to third parties.

The Department will keep and use the personal data and contacts provided by the candidates taking part in the selection procedure also after its completion, for operational, administrative, accounting and/or other purposes related to the management of institutional activities and legal obligations.

Applicants have the right to access their personal data, to request amendments, elimination, limitation of treatment, as well as to object to the processing of the above-mentioned data by addressing their requests to [privacy@unibo.it](mailto:privacy@unibo.it).
